


Q1 Do you expect timely e-mail responses?

Q2 Should frequency coordinators keep an up to date listings of frequencies coordinated on their websites?





Q3 Should Frequency Coordinators show an active list of applications approved, denied, or in progress on their website?





Q4 Should reports/listings on website have dates on them? so you can see how current the information is?





Q5 Do you see a problem with a frequency coordinator having more than 4 repeaters coordinated to himself or a club that he/she is a prime member of?





Q6 Should a un-coordinated repeater that has been on the air for over a year with no notices of interference from a coordinated repeater be given coordiantion if they request it?





Q7 If coordination organization has meetings, should they be open to the amateur radio community to attend?





Q8 Should there be UNLISTED repeater coordinations?




